# Travel Funding Opportunity for Grad Students and Early Career Researchers: International Collaborations in Digital Agriculture

### **UASPSE** Announcement – Request for Proposals

The NSF-funded UASPSE\* project is accepting proposals to use Foreign Travel funds for establishing collaborative research partnerships in the domain of Digital Agriculture. Applications are limited to Early Career researchers (Post-Doctorial Scholars and Pre-Tenure Tenure-Track Faculty), and Graduate Students. Awards will be provided as reimbursements through the *University of North Dakota* after each proposed travel event has been completed.

## **Number of Anticipated Travel Reimbursement Awards: 4-6**

**Total Funding Available:** \$14,500 in Foreign Travel, \$6,000 in Domestic/Participant Travel **Anticipated Size of Proposal Budget:** \$2,500-\$4,000 per award.

• Foreign Travel Funds: \$1,500-\$3,000 per award

• Domestic/Participant Travel Funds: \$1,000 per award

## **Proposal Structure**

Applicants should provide a single-page PDF document describing the proposed collaboration and potential for future collaborative work. This document must include a budget with justification. International (non-domestic) conference attendance related to Digital Agriculture *is* an allowed cost.

#### **Additional Requirements**

- The aim of the proposed project must be to establish a long-term research collaboration in the domain of Digital Agriculture between an Early Career Researcher (or Grad Student) and a foreign partner.
- Proposed project must conform to NSF Policy on Foreign and Domestic/Participant Travel.
- Foreign Travel must be completed before May 31, 2019.
- Foreign Travel will be reimbursed after a 2-page collaboration results report has been filed with the UASPSE PI Team. This report must be filed before *Aug 31, 2019*.
- Domestic travel portion of the award *must be used to attend a UASPSE or Midwest Big Data*\*Hub (MBDH) 2019 event, where the awardee will present a poster on results of the project.

#### **Submission Information & Deadlines**

- The UASPSE project will accept proposal submissions immediately and will continue to do so until all available funding has been allocated.
- Proposal submissions will be reviewed by a 3-person panel consisting of members from the UASPSE PI Team, UASPSE External Advisory Board, and/or the MBDH Steering Committee.
- Competitive submissions will address the following topics:
  - Foreign partner research funds or other support for proposed collaboration;
  - Access provided by collaboration to (new, novel, or restricted) data or methods;
  - o Concrete plans for continuity of the collaboration after travel has occurred;
  - Relevance to UASPSE project outcomes. See website <a href="https://DigitalAg.org">https://DigitalAg.org</a>
